Mark was born and raised in the St. Louis Missouri suburb of Webster Groves and is a life-long Republican and ardent anti-communist. He attended St. Louis Country Day School where he was Captain of the wrestling team and President of the Student Council. He graduated magna cum laude from Southern Methodist University with degrees in Psychology, Sociology and Criminal Justice. He went on to receive his law degree from SMU as well and has spent the last 39 years representing the rights of his fellow citizens. Mark has been married to his wife Patty for 39 years and they have one adult daughter.

On June 28, 2020, and then again on July 3, 2020, he and Patty held off a BLM/ANTIFA mob through the exercise of their 2nd Amendment rights. Since then, they addressed the Republican National Convention, and have been frequent guests on Fox, Newsmax, OAN, CNN and a variety of national and local news and talk TV and radio programs and appeared as a guest commentator or documentary subject in over a dozen foreign countries. Mark and his wife campaigned extensively in support of President Trump and continue to speak around the nation on their support of the Constitution, the traditional values that have made the USA the greatest nation on earth, and the current threats to its continued existence.

Mark, who had never before run for public office, ran for the United States Senate from Missouri to fill the seat of retiring Sen. Roy Blunt.






Rhonda Kuykendall serves on the Texas Human Trafficking Survivor Leader Council. She is a consultant, speaker, legislative advocate, and survivor leader. She recently graduated from the University of Houston – Downtown with a bachelor's in social work and is pursuing her master's in social work at the University of Houston Graduate College of Social Work with a focus on political social work. Working as the Anti-Child Trafficking Consultant for Texas CASA, Rhonda is implementing anti-trafficking protocols in CASA programs across the state. She chairs the Fort Bend County District Attorney's Human Trafficking Community Awareness Team. She serves on the Board of Directors of Child Advocates of Fort Bend and RedM the Movement.

Rhonda received the 2023 Paul H. Chapman National Award from the Foundation for the Improvement of Justice. In 2022, Rhonda received the UHD College of Public Service Social Justice award. Child Advocates of Fort Bend awarded Rhonda the Legislative Advocate of the Year and Child Advocate of the Year in 2019, and in 2015, she received the U.S. Congressional Medal for her work in Austin enacting legislation to protect children from sexual assault.

Rhonda and her husband, Tommy, the former Mayor of Fulshear, Texas, enjoy riding motorcycles, visiting their grown children, and scuba diving.




